

Call for Papers to the 8th Nordic Summer Institute in Labor Economics June 6-7, 2013 in Aarhus

The eight annual Nordic Summer Institute in Labor Economics will take place at the Department of Economics and Business, Aarhus University.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for the best labor scholars in the Nordic countries to get together and to discuss their work. The meeting will contain both contributed and invited papers. The keynote speaker is **Jane Waldfogel**, Columbia University School of Social Work (to be confirmed).

The meeting is organized by the new interdisciplinary center for applied research into effective programs for well-being among children and young people at Aarhus University, in collaboration with the Nordic network in Empirical Labor Economics (ELE).

The meeting will last for two days starting in the morning on June 6th and ending in the evening on June 7th. The organizers will cover accommodation for two nights for all participants and travel costs for presenting authors. The number of participants is limited to 40, and we expect to have about 15 contributed papers.

Papers submitted to the meeting should be sent to **brouland@econ.au.dk** by **March 22**. The local organizers will evaluate all submitted papers and communicate the acceptance decisions by April 3.
