

## **Call for Papers to the 9th Nordic Summer Institute in Labor Economics June 10-11, 2014 in Helsinki**

The ninth annual Nordic Summer Institute in Labor Economics will take place at Paasitorni in downtown Helsinki

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for the best labor scholars in the Nordic countries to get together and to discuss their work. The meeting will contain both contributed and invited papers. The keynote speakers are David Autor from MIT and Janet Currie from Princeton University.

The meeting is organized by Helsinki Center for Economic Research (HECER) and Government Institute for Economic Research (VATT) in collaboration with the Nordic network in Empirical Labor Economics (ELE).

The meeting will last for two days starting in the morning on June 10th and ending in the afternoon on June 11th. Accommodation is reserved from Scandic Paasi right next to conference location. The organizers will cover accommodation for two nights and travel costs for presenting authors. The number of participants is limited to 40, and we expect to have about 15 contributed papers.

The local organizers will evaluate all submitted papers and communicate the acceptance decisions by March 28.
