

Call for Papers to the 7th Nordic Summer Institute in Labour Economics June 5-6, 2012 in Bergen

The seventh annual Nordic Summer Institute in Labour Economics will take place at Bryggen Hotell, in the center of Bergen. There are busses and taxis from the airport to Bergen.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for the best labor scholars in the Nordic countries to get together and to discuss their work. The meeting will contain both contributed and invited papers. The keynote speaker is **Robert Moffitt**, Johns Hopkins University.

The meeting is organized by the Norwegian School of Economics in cooperation the Nordic network in Empirical Labor Economics (ELE)..

The meeting will last for two days starting in the morning on June 5th and ending in the afternoon on June 6th. The organizers will cover travel costs and accommodation from June 4 through June 6. The number of participants is limited to 45, and we expect to have about 15 contributed papers.
